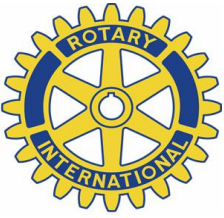

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Guidelines and Conditions for Voluntary Workers at Hyde Park Community Fair

Our Mission:

Is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and to encourage and foster:

- The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarians personal, business and community life;
- The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

Not for Profit: As a "not for profit" organisation, we are reliant on the assistance of volunteers. They are important to us in presenting a successful event.

Attendance: All volunteers attending the Fair are subject to these guidelines and conditions and any directions from The Rotary Club of North Perth.

Work Details: Details of the work to be performed by the Volunteer will be advised on the day of attendance by a designated Volunteer Coordinator

Reporting and Directions: The volunteer acknowledges that the Volunteer is an independent person undertaking to work at Hyde Park voluntarily and there is no relationship of employer and employee or principal and agent. No remuneration will be paid for the work.

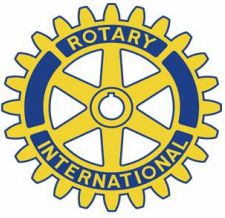
Details and Emergency Contact As legally required by The Rotary Club, all Volunteers must provide, in writing, relevant details for identification purposes and where necessary proof of such identity, along with details of their Emergency Contact being a person readily contactable during the currency of their working at Hyde Park.

Fit for Duty The Volunteer warrants that they are fit for the purpose of acting as a volunteer at Hyde Park and further warrant that they have no known physical or mental condition likely to affect the full time performance of their duties.

Laws and Approvals It is the Volunteer's responsibility to obtain all legal approvals necessary to enable their attendance as a Volunteer and the Volunteer acknowledges that the Rotary Club has no responsibility nor liability for the volunteer failing to obtain such approvals.

Insurance The Rotary Club warrants that it has taken out and maintains both Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance to cover the Volunteer from any claims arising out of liability incurred whilst working at Hyde Park. All other insurance is the Volunteer's responsibility.

Risk The volunteer indemnifies The Rotary Club against all claims arising out of the Volunteer's participation at Hyde Park and such claims include all actions suits costs claims demands brought against The Rotary Club by any person firm or corporation arising out of any negligent or improper act or omission by the Volunteer participating in The Hyde Park Community Fair.



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Loss or damage to property To the extent permitted by law, The Rotary Club shall not be under any liability to the Volunteer in respect of any loss or damage, however caused, which may be suffered or incurred or arise as a result of or in connection with the Volunteer's work, Hyde Park or the Volunteer's presence at Hyde Park for that purpose.

OH&S All volunteers are required to exercise reasonable care in the course of their work and in a manner that ensures the health and safety of themselves and others. Volunteers are required to be aware of and comply with the Occupational Health and Safety requirements of The Rotary Club. These will be advised by the Volunteer Coordinator.

Environmental Obligations The Volunteer must not bring any dangerous, noxious, toxic, volatile, explosive, inflammable or environmentally hazardous substance or compound in any form into Hyde Park and indemnifies The Rotary Club for any damages or claims resulting from any breach of this condition.

Cancellation The Rotary Club reserves the right at its sole discretion to advise the Volunteer that their attendance is no longer required at Hyde Park at any time if there is a breach of these Conditions and Guidelines or for any other reason.

Prohibited Activities This is a smoke and alcohol free event. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol is not permitted at this event.

Privacy Act Information provided to The Rotary Club by the Volunteer could be deemed 'personal information' pursuant to the Privacy Act. This information is collected by The Rotary Club for the purpose of recording this arrangement and ensuring that the records of The Rotary Club are correct and efficient. The Volunteer has the right of access to and alteration of the personal information concerning the Volunteer in terms of Privacy Act.

Publicity The Volunteer acknowledges that the performance of their duties as a volunteer at Hyde Park may result in media attention including but not limited to telecommunication and newspaper and magazine and electronic and print media coverage to themselves, to their activities or to volunteers as a group.
